In the early 1990's, Dan and Tay Henderson began their ministry program at The Salvation Army. Before long, they opened The Lighthouse Ministries, Inc. in downtown Lexington, where they ministered to the homeless, poor, and addicted until 2004 when God called Dan home. Tay continues on with the vision today.



The Lighthouse Ministries' current facility on Elm Tree Lane opened in 1997. It is now filled beyond capacity at each meal, with need growing daily.

Last year at The Lighthouse:

- 35,497 guest meals served
- 900 articles of clothing and toiletry items given away
- 1,200 volunteer hours served
- Weekly Alcoholics Victorious meetings
- Men at a time looking for hope and serving others at The Nehemiah House back-to-work program
